PUBLIC HEARING:
Communicable Disease Protocols

The Phelps-Clifton Springs Central School District is committed to the safety and preparedness of its students, staff and visitors. Our District-Wide School Safety Plan is a comprehensive approach to crisis management and focuses on mitigation/prevention, preparedness, response, and recovery procedures.

An amendment to the State Education Law now requires all schools to update their District-Wide Emergency Response Plan/Safety Plan with a new procedure. This procedure is to cover an emergency created by a "Communicable Disease Event." The District has drafted this procedure and is sharing it with the public for comment as required by this new law.

In addition to this public hearing on the revised plan, a public comment period is open until March 25, 2021, for the public to share any feedback on the plan. Based on guidance from New York State regarding COVID-19, the March 15, 2021 public hearing will be held remotely.
